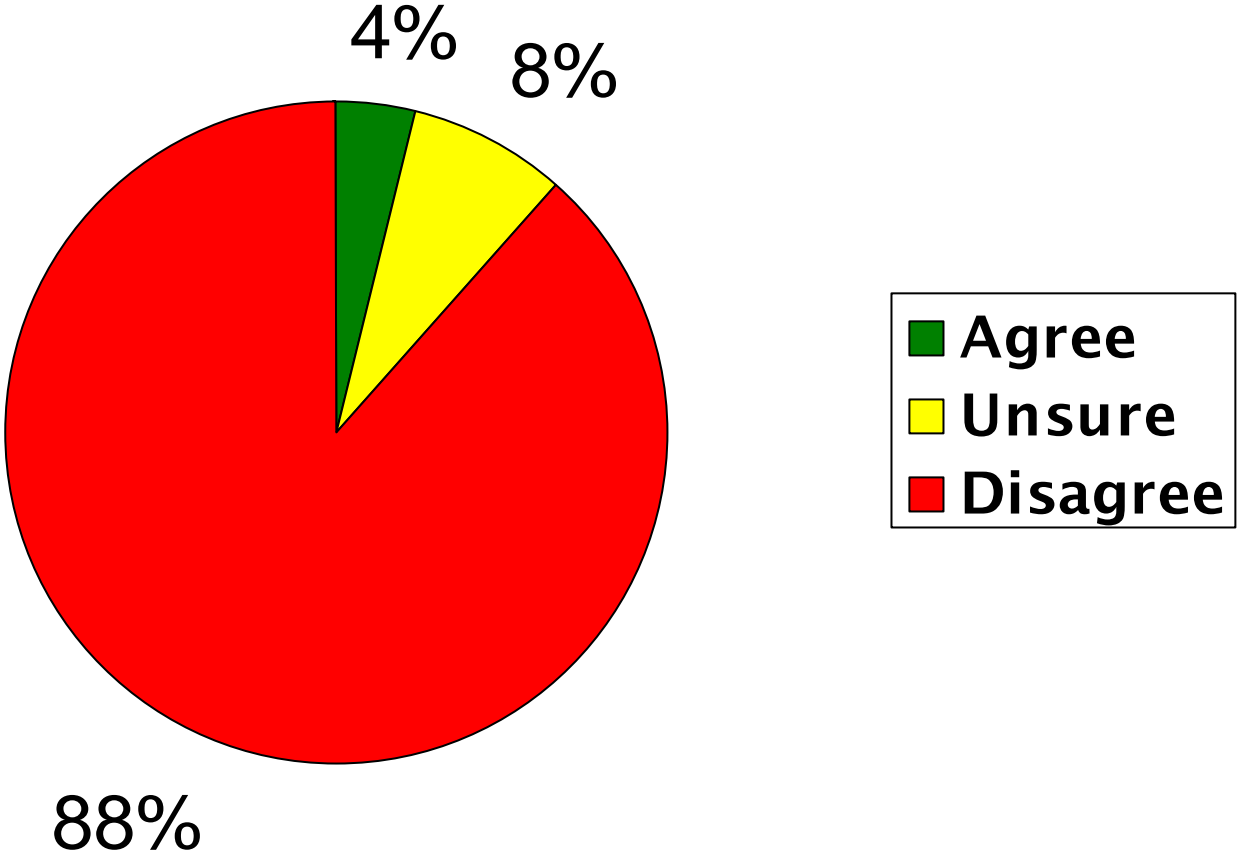

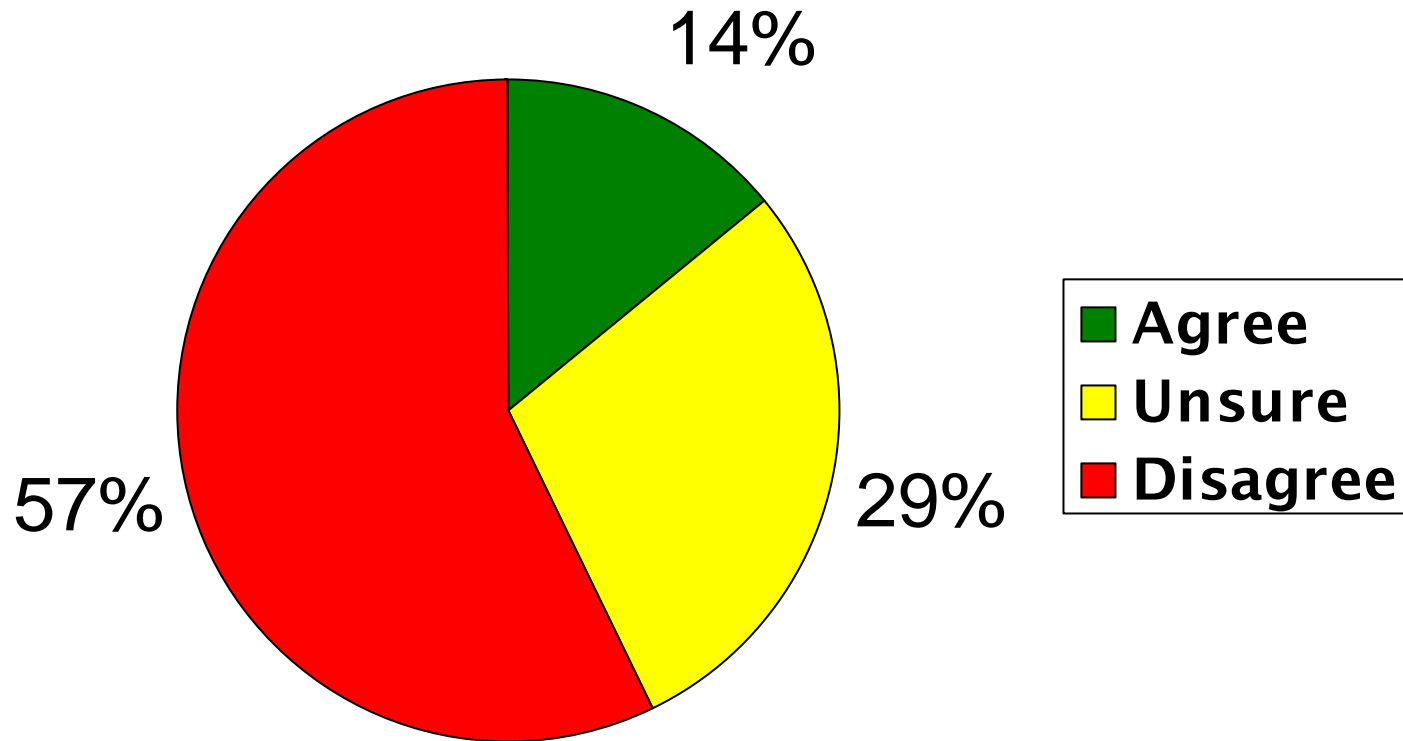
1. We should focus on increasing access to pre-School before we begin efforts to improve quality.
