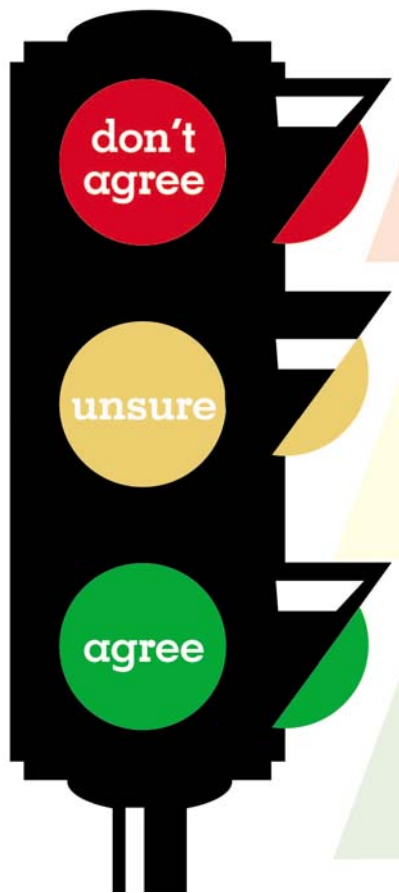

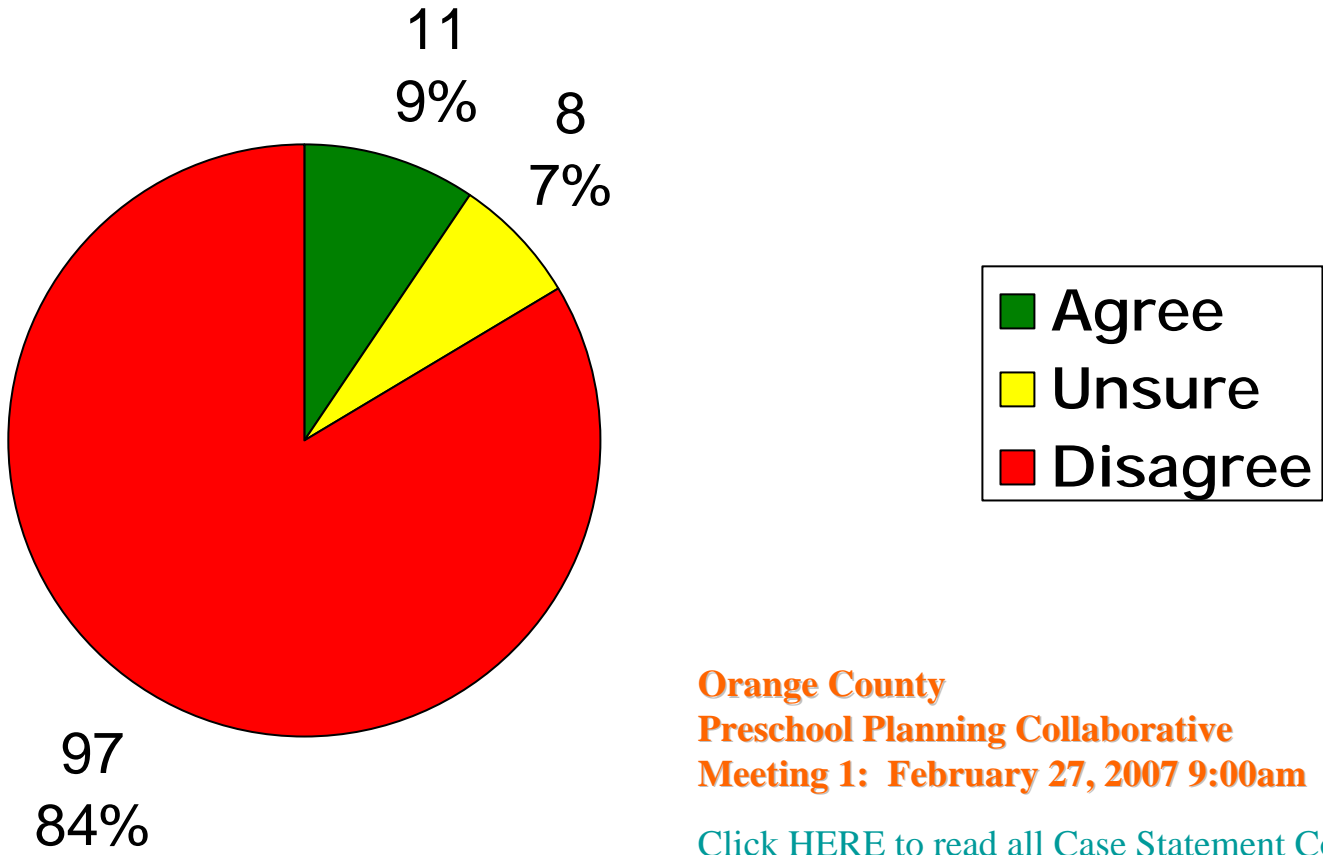

1. Orange County should focus on creating access to preschool only for the children in low-achieving school districts.



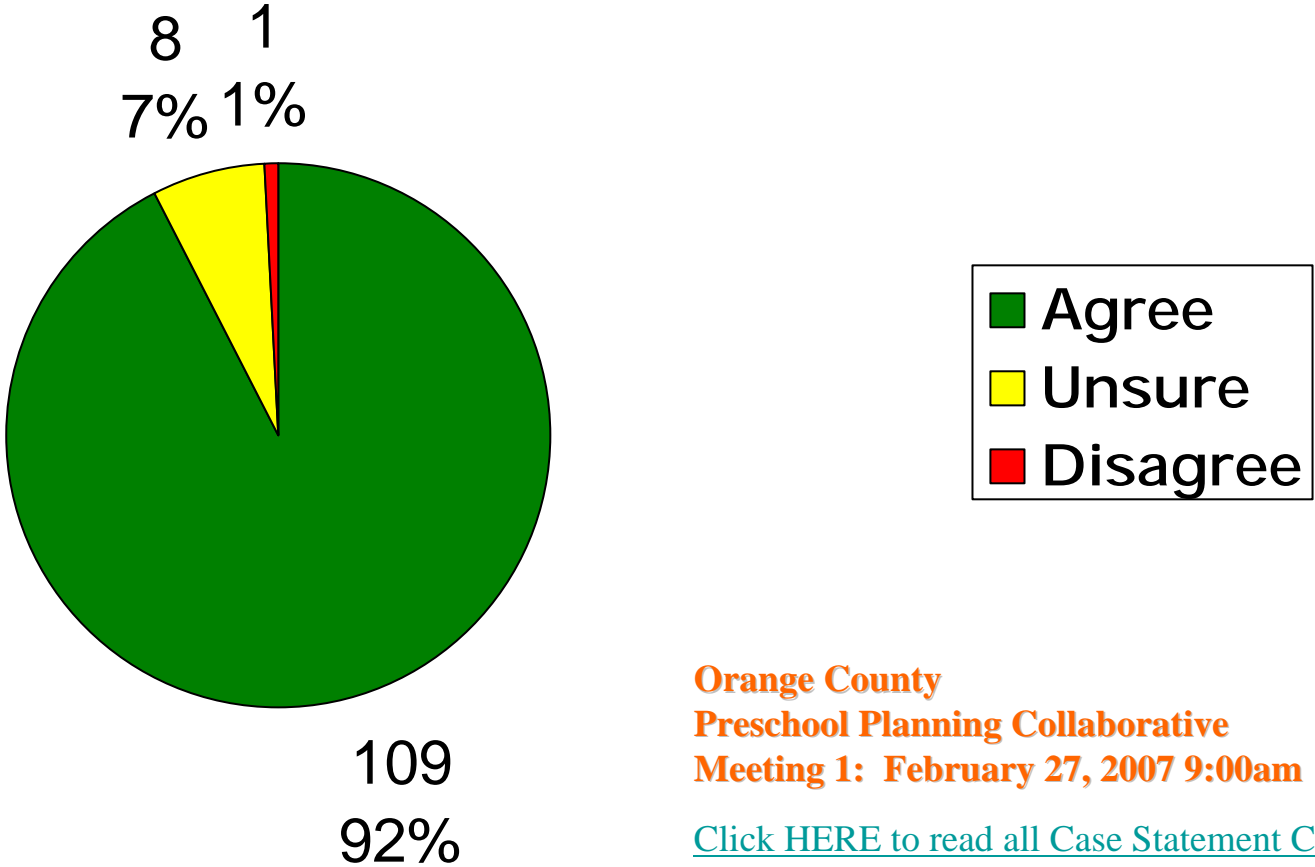
