a. Baseline needs assessment for October

b. Planning Council has a format and data sources for state-mandated needs assessment to standardize data collection

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- i. Must include more detailed and new data collection, beyond existing data sources
 - 1. e.g. use of child care by working and at-home parents
 - 2. PC would have to request specific breakdown for 4-year-olds in order to collect data sought by this group
- ii. Maybe funding from SSA and OCDE School & Community Services
- iii. Mandated every 5 years. Some counties (e.g., LA) conduct NA every 2 years.
